SHARKS in DANGER

Each year, more than 100 million sharks are killed, often for their fins. The mainly Asian demand for shark-fins, used for the prestigious shark-fin soup, is enormous.

At several locations, scientific research has proven that, over the last decades, the numbers of certain sharks species have been decreased with up to 95%!

Sharks are particularly vulnerable to overexploitation because they reproduce very slowly. Some species reach sexual maturity at an age of 15-20 years and produce relatively few young. Because of this, they have hardly a chance to recover ones depleted.

AWARENESS

To create awareness for this, the Protect The Sharks Foundation has created an International Shark Photo Exposition (ISPE). The exposition shows first of all the beauty of this interesting animal, but also pays attention to the worldwide shark-finning problem.

THE EXPOSITION

The exposition consists of unique photographs made by some of the world's best UW-photographers. The host organisation can select its own exposition from a large

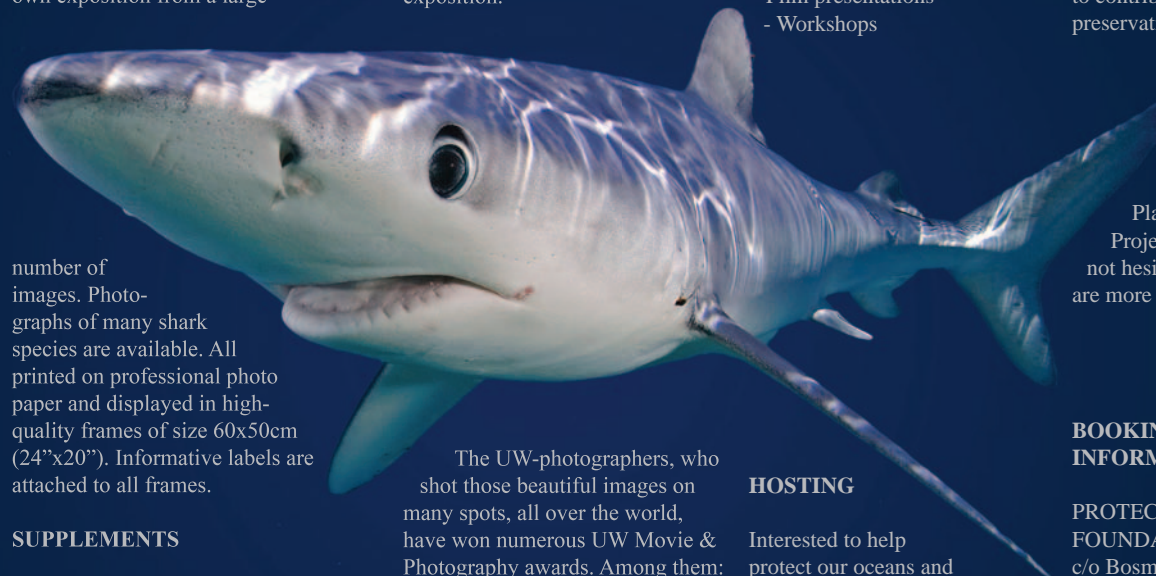
number of images. Photographs of many shark species are available. All printed on professional photo paper and displayed in high-quality frames of size 60x50cm (24"x20"). Informative labels are attached to all frames.

With the exhibition, biographies of the participating photographers, a video clip, banners, educational billboards and advertising posters are made available free of charge.
